Since June 1999 and to date, he has been an independent consultant, having carried out consulting work for the main companies. from Argentina (YPF; Pan American; Total Austral; Wintershall, Capex; President, Medanito, Pluspetrol, Petrobras, etc.), from Bolivia (YPFB Corporación, Chaco and Petrobras Bolivia), from Peru (Petrotech) and Mexico (Burgos Oil Service).
